

DIRECTIONS TO LANGLAND

The Quadrant is a multi-tenanted building in the heart of the historic town of Windsor. All visitors should sign in at the main Reception in the building's atrium and a member of the Langland team will come down to meet you. See page 2 for map.

BY CAR

From the M4

Leave the M4 at Junction 6 and follow the signs to Windsor. Continue to the end of the Windsor Relief Road (dual carriageway) and turn left at the roundabout onto Clarence Road. Follow this road through four sets of traffic lights until you come to a T-junction with a large Georgian House opposite you. Turn left into Sheet Street. The road bears round to the left and becomes the High Street. The Quadrant is on the corner of Sheet Street and the High Street, on the right-hand side of the road.

From the M40

Leave the M40 at Junction 2 (Beaconsfield) and take the A355 South, following the signs to Windsor. The road passes under Junction 6 of the M4. Continue to the end of the Windsor Relief Road (dual carriageway) and turn left at the roundabout onto Clarence Road. Follow this road through four sets of traffic lights until you come to a T-junction with a large Georgian House opposite you. Turn left into Sheet Street. The road bears round to the left and becomes the High Street. The Quadrant is on the corner of Sheet Street and the High Street, on the right-hand side of the road.

From the M25 North

Join the M4 at Junction 12 and follow the directions from the M4.

From the M25 South

Leave the M25 at Junction 13 (A30/B376) and take the A308 to Windsor. As you approach the town, follow the signs to Windsor Town Centre. You will be directed around a roundabout and onto Kings Road, which runs parallel to the castle's Long Walk. Go straight ahead at the traffic lights onto Sheet Street. The road bears round to the left and becomes the High Street. The Quadrant is on the corner of Sheet Street and the High Street, on the right-hand side of the road.

Car Parking

There is very limited visitors' car parking in the underground car park. Please telephone in advance to check if there is a space available on the day of your visit. The underground car park is accessed from St Albans Street, which runs behind the Quadrant. Entry is gained via an intercom to the building's main reception. Once you have parked your car on level -2, you need to walk up the ramp to the car park exit. The automatic gates will let you out. Then turn right, walk round to the front of the building and sign in at reception.

There are several public car parks in the town centre. The nearest are on River Street, Victoria Street and King Edward Court. The nearest car parks are marked on the attached map.

NOTE: The High Street is closed to all traffic most days between 11.00 and 11.40am for the 'Changing of the Guard' at Windsor Castle.

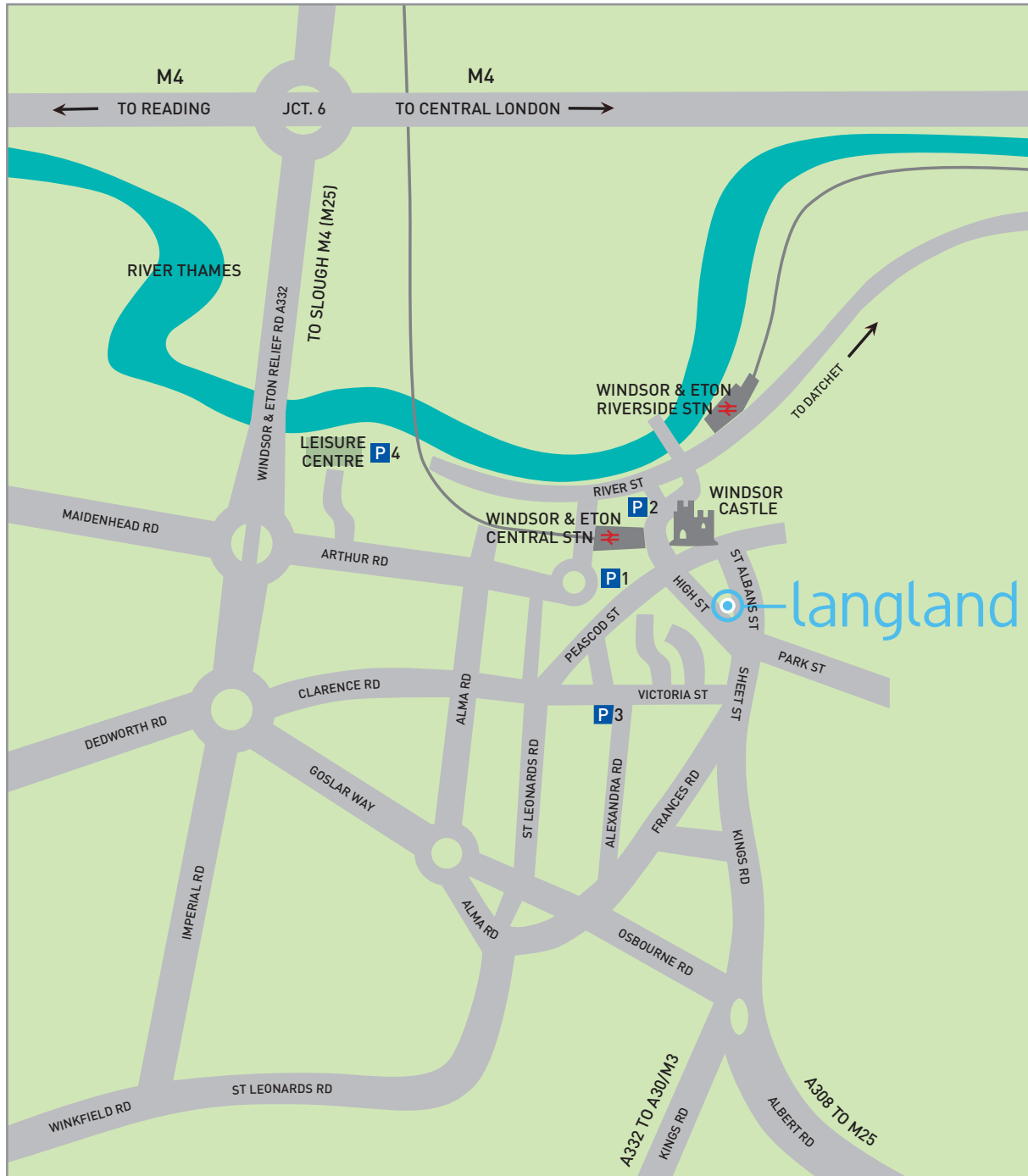
BY TRAIN

From London Paddington, Reading, Wales or the West: take the train to Slough and then change for Windsor & Eton Central.

Leave the railway station complex via the front entrance opposite Windsor Castle. Turn right into the High Street and then cross to the other side of the road via the pedestrian crossing in front of the HSBC bank. Continue walking along the High Street in the same direction. The Quadrant is on the left-hand side, immediately after the Parish Church.

From London Waterloo: take the train to Windsor & Eton Riverside.

Leave the railway station and follow the signs to Windsor Castle. Walk up the hill with the castle on your left, past the castle entrance and along the High Street. The Quadrant is on the left-hand side, immediately after the Parish Church.
